We'll do everything we can do to make your visit safe, but you can help us by following our new procedures and listening to our staff and volunteers.



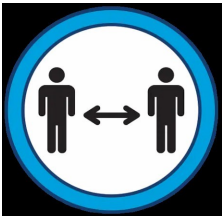
WEAR A MASK
